Prevent Mosquito Bites

Look for one of these Active Ingredients: DEET, Picaridin, or Oil of Lemon Eucalyptus.

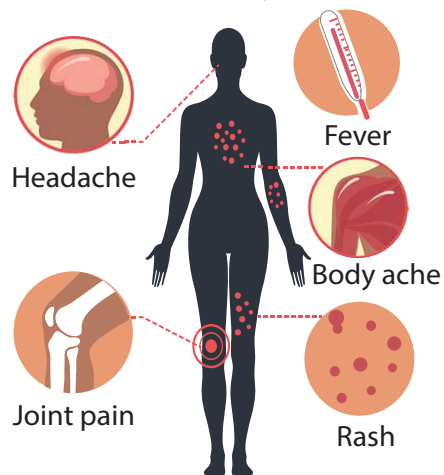


Active Ingredient:

Oil of lemon eucalyptus.....	30%
Other ingredients.....	70%
Total.....	100%

According to the CDC, higher percentages of active ingredient provide longer protection.

West Nile virus or St. Louis encephalitis symptoms

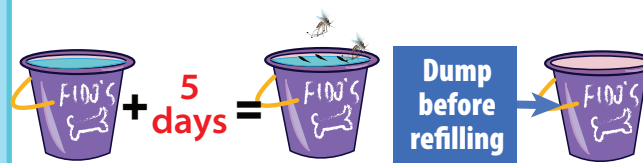
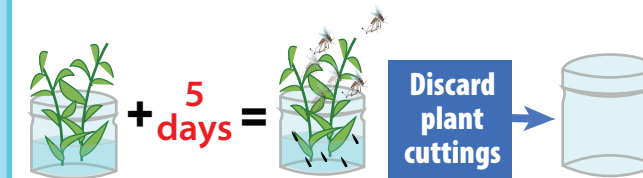
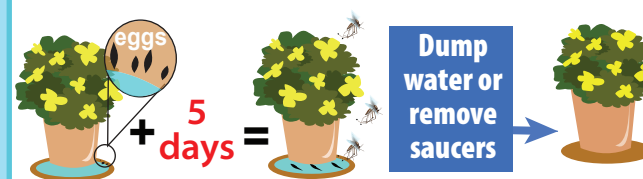

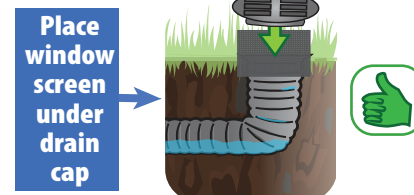
These viruses are not spread by *Aedes aegypti* mosquitoes.

Prevent Mosquito Development

inside and outside your home.



Cover all yard drains, even if they look dry!



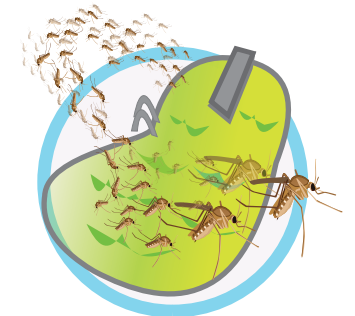
- Screen or add foam inserts
- Check monthly
- Buy window screen at a local hardware store

Curb-side drains



- Buy "drain tube foam insert" online

Report unmaintained swimming pools or water features.



Keep Mosquitoes Out

Keep unscreened doors closed

Keep unscreened windows closed



Be aware security doors may not keep mosquitoes out.
